Proposed Amendment 1 🛃

This Amendment would allow the Louisiana Legislature to create trial courts of specialized jurisdiction and provide supreme court original jurisdiction to discipline out-of-state lawyers

Proposed Amendment 2 🥨



This Amendment would change some of Louisiana's rules about taxes, government spending, and teacher pay. This Amendment is a grab bag of changes, but at its core it cuts funding for early, special and K-12 education as well as roads and infrastructure maintenance.



Proposed Amendment 3 🟠 🆍

This Amendment would allow the Louisiana Legislature to decide which crimes could lead to a juvenile being tried as an adult. Additionally, this would allow lawmakers to change rules over time without needing a constitutional amendment.

Proposed Amendment 4 💽 🚞

This Amendment would allow the state to fill the vacancies for new courts using the earliest election date allowed by state law which are often low turnouts.

ELECTION ON CONSTITUTIONAL AMENDMENTS VOTE NO ON ALL

During the 2024 Special "Tax" Session, the Louisiana Legislature made moves to fundamentally change the Louisiana Constitution and grab power from the people. Starting March 15th, voters have the opportunity to say NO to all 4 proposed constitutional amendments.

AMENDMENT 1 SHADY SPECIALTY COURTS

Vote "No" on 1: The Legislature will get a blank slate to create courts outside the current structure, and appoint unelected magistrates to take over our democracy.

AMENDMENT 2 TAX CUTS FOR THE RICH

Vote "No" on 2: Louisiana does not need more tax cuts for the rich, and we do not need any new taxes.

AMENDMENT 3 DISMANTLING JUVENILE JUSTICE



Vote NO on 3: Louisiana already allows kids aged 13-16 to be sentenced to life without parole for serious crimes. This amendment would give lawmakers free reign to impose mandatory minimums for lesser offenses, sentence kids to decades in prison without parole, and place them on adult probation—making it easier to send them back to prison. It's a slippery slope toward dismantling the juvenile justice system entirely.

AMENDMENT 4 TINKERING WITH JUDICIAL ELECTIONS

Vote "No" on 4: The law already allows us to fill a judicial vacancy, or new judgeship, on the "next available" election date. There is no need to pass this amendment.
